Christian Worldview¹ - 5 Foundational Propositions²

March 2023

3/5-11 Focus: God has Given Us Understanding – Our Biblical worldview is established and preserved in our relationship with God through Jesus.

Statement: Read 1 John 5:20

Discussion: Identify elements of this verse that speak to our spiritual understanding and how we can be sure of it.

Statement: It is through our relationship with Jesus Christ that we receive understanding and can be confident in it.

Discussion: How does the pursuit of Unity and of Truth often create tension? How should we navigate this tension?

How will you respond? How can we pray for you?

3/12-18 Focus: Foundational Orientation – The prime proposition of the Christian worldview concerns the nature of God.

Statement: For centuries, alternate views to Theism have greatly proliferated in the last few generations.

Discussion: You can use your phone for this one - How many worldviews can you identify? Name as many as you can.

Statement: We must think, speak, live and exhort in a manner that is consistent with a God-centered worldview.

Discussion: What are some prevailing worldviews that contradict what we know to be true about God and His creation?

How will you respond? How can we pray for you?

3/19-25 Focus: Foundational Proposition #1 – God is infinite, personal, transcendent, immanent, omniscient, sovereign, immutable and good.

Statement: Our confidence through Jesus Christ helps us not only identify these characteristics of God, but helps us defend them.

Discussion: Can you describe these and many other attributes or characteristics of God to others? Take some time to discuss them.

Statement: Implication: God is absolute truth and the only truth.

Discussion: How does our pursuit of truth in God overcome the falsehood of competing worldviews?

How will you respond? How can we pray for you?

3/26-1 Focus: Foundational Proposition #2 – Human beings are created in the Image of God and thus are like God in certain ways. (Gen. 1:26-28)

Statement: The personal and relational attributes of man are established in us by a loving and just God.

Discussion: Formal and informal relationships between people are defined by God. How do worldviews corrupt what God has created?

Statement: Implication: As images of God, we are intelligent, moral, creative, and even rulers.

Discussion: What does this intimate image say about us and to us? How would you describe the limitations that naturally exist in each of these categories. (We are a likeness of God, but we are Not God)

How will you respond? How can we pray for you?
